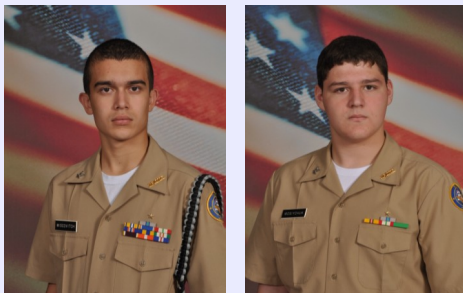


Who's Ahead?
